The Moodle Support Team would like to help you kick it off by introducing our new **Monday Moodle Tips**. This week, we wanted to share a quick tip about students in your classes who may need extra quiz time:

### User Overrides

If you have a student with a disability in your course who needs an accommodation for online quizzes, like extra quiz time, you can adjust time limits and due dates for individual students using "user overrides" for your quiz:

1. From your course homepage, click on your quiz.
2. Click User Overrides from the Settings block
3. Click the "add a user override" button
4. Choose a student or students from the list and adjust the settings
5. Click Save and you're all done!
