Our Moodle site is unable to translate these files, I'm sorry to say. Regardless of input method, I receive a number of errors about the way these questions have been formatted and Moodle will not accept them. Since these are short-answer, it's possible the problem is that WebCT allows for questions with more than one answer where Moodle does not (this will cause questions to be rejected). Unless I find a way around this, you might be out of luck on this front.

Many WOU instructors successfully import Blackboard format quiz questions into Moodle from their textbook providers, though. If you have another type of resource or activity, would you be so kind as to share an example with me? I'd be happy to test importing for you to ensure that it works as well.

The answer to your questions about WebCT and Blackboard are both the same: Maybe. Moodle can definitely import some Blackboard resources (i.e. quiz questions) and I believe that older versions of Moodle supported some WebCT cross-over. However, I must admit that I've never tried to import from WebCT with more recent versions. Let me take a look and I'll get back to you when I have a more definitive answer.
