Key responsibilities include:

- The Western Oregon University Foundation assists in building financial support for its educational, research, and public service activities, and coordinates the efforts of several university support groups.
- The Jensen Arctic Museum is one of only two museums in the lower 48 states devoted solely to Arctic culture and ecology.
- Gentle House is a 19th century Victorian-era country home located in a lovely pastoral setting which has been renovated for use as a location for weddings and as a conference and meeting center.
- The Smith Fine Arts Series offers the best in fine arts entertainment at affordable prices, right here on the Western campus.
- The office of Public Relations and Communications produces press releases and news stories for media outlets, as well as the design for external promotional publications for the university.

Volunteer service groups

Several active volunteer service groups are supported by the Office of University Advancement and the WOU Foundation.

- The Alumni Association helps thousands of the university's alumni stay in touch with each other, and support Western.
