As part of AAOT electives, students are encouraged to explore possible courses to be applied to an optional minor at WOU. Popular minors for psychology majors include: Gerontology, Health, Social Sciences, Forensic Psychology, Organizational Leadership and Spanish. However, most WOU minors can be combined with a psychology major.

The exact number of electives required for the psychology major will depend on the number of PSY courses transferred from Chemeketa. Psychology majors must include a minimum of 40 of the required 62 credits of 300- and 400-level coursework.
